- Submitted written test as requested
- Submitted live fire requirement as requested

- Communication problems and delays

2nd appointment for CCW to pay fees and submit application

- Told I must write good cause in the Investigators section 7 on page 13 of application
- Application states to leave blank
- Tried to submit exhibit A which had written answers for Investigator
- Told to submit 3 local letters of reference/character
- Submitted U.S. mail delivered and received at Driscoll Drive address
- Submitted additional information for various reasons

Told to complete California approved CCW training

- Paid for and completed required CCW training 100 round and written test
- Submitted evidence of successful CCW training completion

Told to qualify at Sheriff's Range

- Went to range on March 11th and took exact same test and qualified with 15 rounds
